- Physical demonstrations of proficiency in techniques learned in training



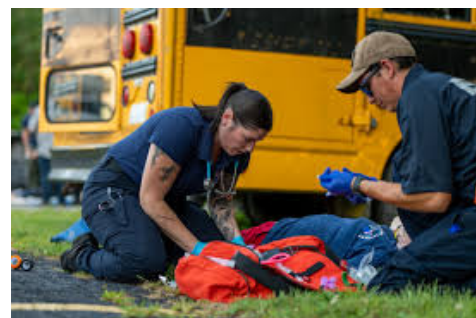
## What You Receive
